Year3/4 – 20 minutes.

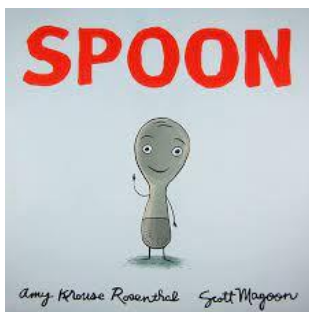
Year 5/6 – 30 minutes

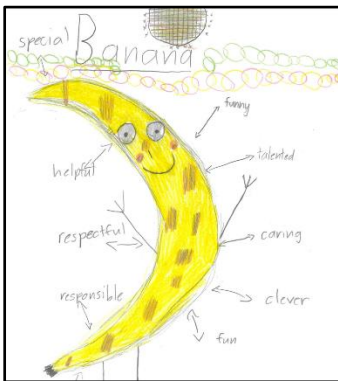
**Spoon and Egg are inanimate objects. Students created a character from an inanimate object and listed character traits around the object.**



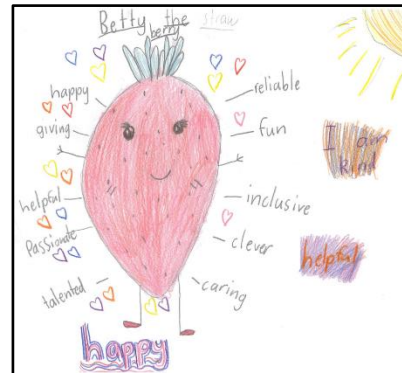
